(iv) Adjectives that end in **'y'**, we **remove the 'y' and add 'ily'**.

● happy ➡ _____

(v) If the adjectives end with **'le'**, we **replace the final 'e' with 'y'** to form adverbs.

● terrible ➡ _____

(vi) Adjectives ending with **'ic'**, we simply **add 'ally'**.

● ironic ➡ _____

(vii) There are few adjectives that we don't need to change anything to form adverbs.
(e.g. fast-fast; hard-hard)

(viii) There are few adjectives that we need to change the whole words to form adverbs.
(e.g. good-well)
